



How to Leave a Gift in Your Will

Leaving a gift (or bequest) through your will is a great way to make a bigger impact on the causes you care most about. You can designate a **specific bequest** or a **residual bequest**:

Specific Bequests allow you to designate a percentage of your estate, a dollar amount, or specified assets as a gift to Sierra Harvest.

Sample language: I give, devise and bequeath _____ [% or \$ amount] to Sierra Harvest, located in Nevada City, California, to be used for general charitable purposes to support and further Sierra Harvest's Mission.

Residual Bequests allow you to designate the remaining residue of your estate as a gift to Sierra Harvest, *after* the payment of all expenses and specific bequests to loved ones have been made.

Sample language:

I give, devise and bequeath to Sierra Harvest, located in Nevada City, California, all [or state a percentage] of the rest and residue of my estate to be used for general charitable purposes to support and further Sierra Harvest's Mission.
